1. Gloria Cruz and Bryan William Lewis, City Charter Commission Q&A

- Commission was appointed in 2020, every 10 years the charter gets reviewed for changes.
- The Commission if it has supermajority 15 or more agree that the City Charter needs to be amended, then it can be sent to the voters.
- Reforms/Charter Amendments are going to be sent to be voted on in June 2022 for the November 2022 election.
- Lots of community engagement on changes to the charter review process.
- Portland is the only city in the US that has a commission form of government. Major assigns commissioners bureaus.
- Four Commissioners are at large for the whole city. Current system.
- New system will be a City Council/Mayor government with a Chief Administrative Office who will run the bureaus and deliver services. The Mayor and Commissioners (non-partisan) will carry out laws and manage the budget. The city administrator will be nominated by the Mayor to the Council Members to vote on.
- This new type of government will be made of multi-member districts - 4 districts with 3 council members per district. With ranked choice voting. This will eliminate the May election.
- Mayor will have executive power without veto power.
- Commissioners will need to live in the District they represent. All three commissioners will be elected at the same time. Half the commissioners will be elected in Presidential years (4 year term).
